

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Driveways and culverts

You must obtain permission from Mr. Valence before installing a culvert. Culverts must have at least 18 inches in diameter, and you must maintain it and remove anything that may cause obstruction. Your driveway must be 6 inches lower than the road, to ensure that water drains properly. If this is impossible due to your location, you must dig a ditch in your driveway so that the water runs directly into it without damage to the road.

Right-of-way

Do not place anything within 4 meters of the road; no signs, rocks, fences, decorations, or other to avoid causing damage when the snow-blower or the motor grader passes.

Hunting and fishing

"Hunter on the lookout" or similar signs must be posted within 100 meters of your cache, they are not permitted in the vicinity of roads or trails. It is forbidden to cut down trees to build new trails. Limit the use of ATVs in the woods during the hunting season.

All laws and regulations apply during rifle/shotgun season, stay away from homes and roads. The catch limit is ten (10) trouts per day, per land. A fishing permit is mandatory even if you only fish in the Domaine des Appalaches Inc. lakes.

Please remember to bring containers to bring back all your garbage, leaving no traces behind. If you happen to see a poacher, do not hesitate to call 1-800-463-2163.

Wood cutting

It is strictly forbidden to cut down trees anywhere on the Domaine des Appalaches Inc., except on your own property.
