

RECYCLING

Paper: newspaper, magazines, phone books, and all other paper not dirtied by food or grease.

Cardboard: boxes, cardboard packaging, and all contaminated cartons that aren't contaminated with food or grease.

Plastics: all hard plastics that have the recycling symbol on the back.

Glass: all glass containers that are emptied and rinsed (no flat glass such as glass shards, mirrors, light bulbs or dishes).

Metals: all containers such as cans (aluminum or iron). No building materials and car parts.

Electronic recyclable items: computers, parts and accessories, cables, batteries, cellular phones, TVs, cameras, VHSs, etc.

Each year, there are special pick-up for dangerous products (paint, tenner...), tires, appliances, etc. check with our office for dates and details.
